TIMES: The consideration times shown below for the National Open Championships must have been achieved in accredited events since 1st December 1993. The organisers reserve the right to restrict entries and alter session start times in order to ensure not only a good standard but a smoothly operated meet. Entry times should be 50m times or 50m conversion times.

FORMAT: The National Championships are Open to all swimmers.

**ELIGIBILITY
TO COMPETE:**

1. Competitors must be amateurs, except for the special Master's Category and have paid their current Annual Competitive Fee to the appropriate Association before submitting their entries to any event.
2. Winners of Scottish National and National Junior Titles must be either:
 - a) A native of Scotland;
 - or b) A person with a Scottish father or mother;
 - or c) Resident in Scotland for a minimum period of 6 months prior to the first day of the competition.
3. The Junior Championship Trophy/Title will be awarded to the fastest Junior with National eligibility, as above, in the Open Championship Final. In Heat Declared Winner events the Trophy/Title will be awarded to the fastest Junior in the event. In the circumstances of no Junior with National eligibility reaching the Final, the Trophy/Title will go to the fastest Junior in the Heats.
4. Juniors may compete in Senior events. Juniors are defined as under 17 years of age at midnight on the 31st December in the year of competition.
5. A swimmer changing Clubs in 1994 and committed to the first Club shall swim unattached for the remainder of the set period. A swimmer entering the Championship as unattached cannot compete for a Club in Relay events.

FINALS: The fastest heat of the men's 1500m and women's 800m Freestyle events will be held in the evening Finals session.

Open Championship Finals will be held in the evening session and will consist of the fastest 8 qualifiers from Open Heats.

Consolation Finals will be held in all events (excluding HDW events) where 25 or more swimmers compete.

If there are eight or fewer competitors/teams in an event then that event will move to a Straight Final, in the Finals position within the programme.

TEAM LINES:

Team Line Forms will be available at the Recorders table and should be returned to the Recorder duly completed with the swimmers' names and current registration numbers before the start of the session. Swimmers who are not eligible for Robertson Trophy points should be identified by an "A" prefix to their registration number on all Team lines.

It should be noted that for Robertson Trophy points the rule stated on page 4 of the 92/93 addendum to the handbook referring to page 54 rule CS10(8) will be applied.

Clubs entering Junior Teams (16 years and under) should highlight this on the entry form. Clubs may enter 2 Open Relay teams and 1 Junior Relay Team. Swimmers cannot be transferred between Teams. A maximum of 2 teams per Club will count in the Robertson trophy. Counting Teams to be identified prior to their swims.

ENTRIES:

The closing date for receipt of entries is :-

All Entry Forms (Copies enclosed) should be submitted along with the appropriate fee. Photocopies in the correct colour are acceptable. (No Time Cards are Required)

No entries will be accepted without correct fee or with forms incorrectly completed.

Please note that no refunds will be made from accepted entries. Reserve swimmers who do not get a swim will have their entry fee returned after the championship.

PLEASE NOTE:

The rule covering those swimmers eligible to gain points for their Club in the Robertson Trophy is detailed in the paragraph on Team Lines. Please identify your Club swimmers who do **NOT** comply with this rule with the prefix A to the registration number on the entry form.

WITHDRAWALS:

Lists of accepted participating swimmers, complete with time cards in each event, will be posted to each Club. Any withdrawals or amendments prior to the first day of the Championships should be notified to the Entries/Withdrawals Secretary initially by telephone and confirmed by letter or fax:-

Withdrawals on the day of the Championship should be notified to the Recorders prior to the start of the appropriate Heats session.

ENTRY CARDS:

Entry cards should be posted in the card posting box at the information desk in the spectator area at the shallow end of the pool 45 minutes prior to the start of the appropriate Heat session. Time Cards, complete with heat and lane number, will be available for uplifting at the Information desk. An announcement will be made when the cards are ready. Start Sheets will also be available from the Information desk on production of a Coaches Pass. Finalists Time Cards should be uplifted from the Recorders table which is situated at the Deep End of the Pool, opposite the Diving Pool. Should you wish to withdraw from a Final you must inform the Recorders **IN WRITING** within 30 minutes of the Finalists List being published and displayed on the windows of the Teaching Pool at the shallow end.

DRUG TESTING:

Please note that drug testing may be in operation at this event. All swimmers not registered with the Scottish Amateur Swimming Association will be required to sign an agreement to undergo tests as required in accordance with FINA law. NB Scottish swimmers will have signed an agreement when submitting their Annual Competitive Fee.

COACHES:

Coaches passes are available as follows:-

1 Pass per Club - Free (inclusive of entry, programme, and results)

Additional passes can be obtained at a cost of £5. Requests and monies should be submitted with entries.

AWARDS:

Medals/Trophies shall be presented as follows:-

- a) Scottish Open Championship 1st, 2nd & 3rd.
- b) Scottish National Champion
- c) Scottish National Junior Champion

In addition the following trophies will be awarded.

1) **Berger Paints Trophy**

Awarded for the Best Performance (Male or Female) by a Scottish Swimmer in the National Open Championship. Calculated using the current German Points Tables.

2) **Robertson Trophy (Club Championship)**

- i) The award shall be made to a Club registered with the Scottish Amateur Swimming Association.
- ii) Competition shall be confined to events in the National Open Championship.
- iii) The Trophy shall be awarded to the Club gaining the highest total of points awarded as follows (Male and Female combined).

1st Place	8 Points
2nd Place	7 Points
3rd Place	6 Points
4th Place	5 Points
5th Place	4 Points
6th Place	3 Points
7th Place	2 Points
8th Place	1 Point

Relay Points count double those above

- iv) Eligibility of competing swimmers is covered previously in this Information sheet as is the number of scoring teams per Club.
- v) Robertson Trophy points will be awarded to Eligible Swimmers as stated previously, swimming with Scottish Clubs by ranking from Finals/Heats as detailed above.
- vi) Failure to comply with the requests covering eligibility may result in the disqualification of the Team.

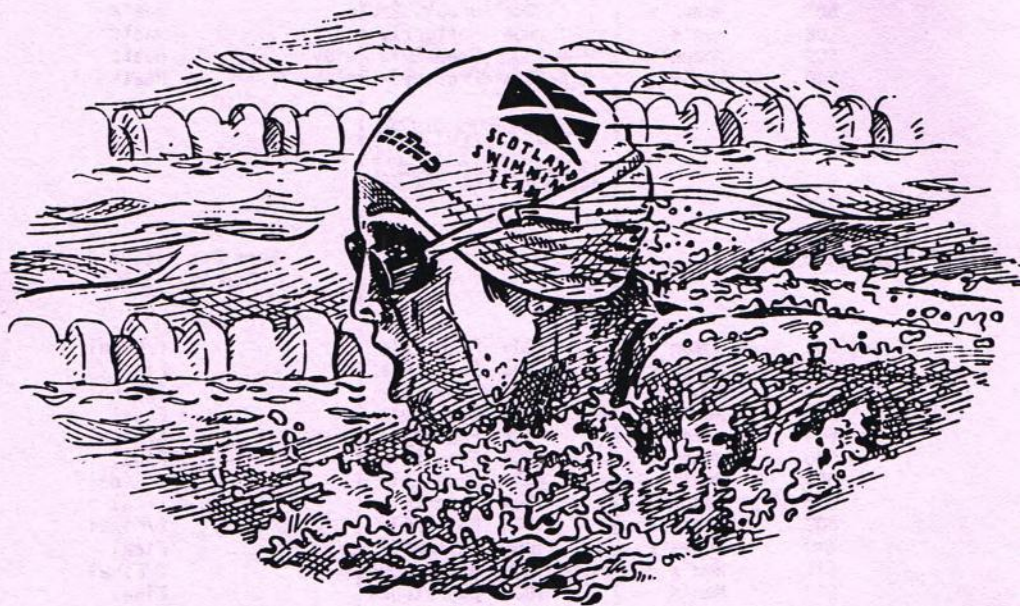
