Minutes. The minutes of the previous meeting were read & adopted on the motion of Mr J Foster & seconded by Mr Mc Neil.

Correspondence A Letter was read from Paisley Anchor Club asking permission to alter the Ladies 50 yds Team Race to be held at their gala, to a 50 yds Handicap, confined to ladies in Anchor & Ferguslie Works, also asking permission to hold a School Boys' Handicap, & greasy pole competition open to Paisley. It was unanimously agreed to grant permit as desired.

Fairfield Club asked permission to hold a 50 yds race for Naval Volunteers, at their gala on Sept 8th, which was granted without dissent.

Saltcoats A.S.C. were unanimously granted permission to alter their gala date from 15th July to 5th August. Gourock A.S.C. asked permission to hold a gala on 29th July. The Secretary having granted this, his action was honoerated without dissent.

A letter was read from Paisley Club asking an interpretation of Rule 8 of W.C. Polo Cup Rules, re neutral Bath for W. Counties Cup Final Tie. After a great deal of discussion Mr McIntyre moved & Mr J G Mc Lachlan seconded that the final tie be played in Paisley.

Mr J K Sheddell moved & Mr J Moore seconded that the final be played in a neutral Bath, which means outside

Correspondence of Paisley. The amendment was carried by 24 votes to 15.

Treasurer's Report The Hon. Treasurer presented his report showing a balance of £20-16-10½. He also moved its adoption which was agreed to.

The Treasurer was instructed to write Clubs whose fees were not paid, pointing out that unless fees were paid at once, swimmers of these Clubs would be debarred from taking part in competitions & Clubs would be liable to be suspended at next meeting.

There were no offers for the 100 yds race, Team Race, & the Sladen Trophy District Race.
