Motherwell Gala. Cheque forwarded to treasurer.

Eastern A.S.C. Club ask for permission to hold a team race  
on 30<sup>th</sup> Dec 07. Same granted by Secretary and  
homologated.

#### Treasurers Report.

Polo League Cup. Through a misunderstanding on the part of the Paisley Amateurs Club Officials this cup was not available for presentation. Mr Irvine offered explanation which was accepted.
