

Minutes of the Monthly Meeting of the W.C.A. held within the City Halls Glasgow on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> July 1910 at 8 o'clock p.m. The President Mr J. B. Keir (Fairfield) presided over a good attendance of delegates.

*Minutes* The minutes of the previous monthly meeting were read and adopted unanimously.

*Correspondence* A number of letters were read intimating changes in club delegates. These were approved of without objection.

A letter was read from Gourock club intimating date of 7<sup>th</sup> mile championship of Scotland as 30<sup>th</sup> July and asking permits for same which was granted.

A communication was read in which Kinning Park club made application for permits to hold a gala on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> Aug<sup>th</sup>. The action of the Secretary in granting the permits was homologated without dissent.

Glasgow Foundry Boys asked permission to hold a gala on 29<sup>th</sup> Sept<sup>th</sup> and this was unanimously granted.

Saracen Club were likewise granted permission to hold a gala on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October.



A letter was read in which Helensburgh a/sb asked permission to hold a 50 yards race confined to members of a newly formed <sup>ladies</sup> club in Helensburgh at their gala on 1<sup>st</sup> Augt. This was unanimously granted.

Ferguslie a/sb in a letter asked permitt to hold a gala 11<sup>th</sup> October and this was granted.

A letter was read in which Maryhill Victoria a/sb asked a permit, to hold a 50 yards race for Boy Scouts and Boys Brigade at their gala on 17<sup>th</sup> September. This was granted with the proviso that any Boy Scouts participating must not be members of an affiliated club.

Saltcoats a/sb in a letter asked permitt to hold 3 open events - 100 yds and 50 yds gents & 50 yards ladies (handicap) at their gala on 16<sup>th</sup> July & this was granted without dissent.

Fairfield a/sb asked permission to have a polo match Govan & Paisley v Glasgow at their gala on 9<sup>th</sup> Sept and their request was granted. The selection of the teams was remitted to the Polo Committee.



A letter was read in which the Paisley Police Club applied for admission to the membership of the W.C.A.S.A. This club only remitted 7/6 instead of 10/6 and it was agreed to admit them if a additional 3/- was remitted. Secretary to write accordingly.

A letter was read from Mr James Laird reporting J. Gray of Paisley Victoria was sending his wrong time for 50 yards at the recent gala of the Paisley Victoria club and also pointing out that the practice of giving inaccurate information was increasing. He also asked that the association should appoint Timekeepers for galas. A member of the Paisley Victoria club gave an explanation in reference to Gray's case after which it was remitted to the club to deal with Gray. As to the other matter of Timekeepers the Chairman pointed out that there was a rule governing their appointment.

Treasurer's Report The Hon. Treasurer presented his report showing a balance of £ . The report was unanimously adopted.

Water Polo Committee report The Convenor presented his report and moved its adoption. Mr J. H. Skeddew took exception to that part of the report dealing with



the suspension of A. Logan of the

reconsideration and with instructions

Water Polo League Report to the W. C. A. S. A.

read in City Hall on 6th July, 1910.

Mr. Chairman,

Gentlemen,

Since the last meeting of the Western Counties A.S.A. the League Committee have held two meetings. At the first held in City Hall on 15th June there were present Messrs. W. Slimmon, J. G. McLauchlin, J. Foster Jr., A. Wallace and the Convener O.W.D. McKenzie. A letter was read from the Thistle A.S.C. requesting that their League Match on June 22nd be postponed owing to  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile Scottish Championship on that date. It was decided that the match be played on 5th July. A letter was read from Western Baths intimating that they would be unable to fulfill their engagement with 2nd Paisley on 21st June and enclosing fine of 1/6. Letters were read from Springburn and Paisley Victoria regarding the result of their League Match on 12th May. As the Referee of the Match failed to put in an appearance at the Meeting it was decided to adjourn the case till next League Meeting. With reference to the finding of Committee re South Side and Paisley Match on 12th May, which the Western Counties took exception to on 1st June, it was decided to call evidence regarding said Match for next League Meeting.

A letter was read from Mr. A. Davidson, Gartsherrie, stating that Fairfield had failed to put in an appearance at Paisley on May 31st. It was decided to fine Fairfield 1/6d. and award the points to Paisley.

This was all the business.

At the second meeting held in Gorbals Baths on 4th July there were present Messrs. J. B. Reid, W. Slimmon, J. G. McLauchlin, J. Foster Jr., A. Wallace and the Convener, O. W. D. McKenzie. The adjourned case of the Paisley Victoria and Springburn dispute was decided in favour of Springburn after evidence had been given



by J. Logan Paisley Victoria ----- Messrs. T. McClymont, W. Meldrum and D. Adams, Springburn. The Referee of the disputed match, Mr. P. S. Fraser, concurred. With reference to the adjourned case of the South Side and Paisley unfinished Match on 12th May, after evidence had been given by Messrs. J. Storrie, Paisley and J. D. Morton, South Side, the Committee awarded the Match to Paisley, owing to the South Side team being late. Letters were read from the Springburn scratching to Govan Y.M.C.A. on 15th and 21st June and to Paisley Victoria on 23rd June. It was decided to fine Springburn 4/6d and award the points to the opposing teams. Letters were read from Mr. W. A. Lawson and Mr. A. Neilson with reference to a disputed goal in the League Match between Thistle and 2nd Western Baths on 15th June owing to some misunderstanding between the timekeeper, Mr. W. Kirkwood and Mr. W. A. Lawson the Referee. It was decided that the disputed goal be not allowed. Fairfield scratched to Paisley Victoria on 16th June and were fined 1/6d, and the points awarded to opposing team.
