Minutes The minutes of the previous meeting were  
read & adopted on the motion of Mr

Correspondence A number changes in Club Delegates were  
intimated and approved of

A letter from Glasgow Hibernian A.S.C. was  
read intimating that this Club did not  
intend holding a Gala on 4<sup>th</sup> October as  
previously arranged

A letter was read in which the Kilmarnock  
A.S.C. desired to hold a gala on 28<sup>th</sup> Sept.  
It was unanimously agreed that the action  
of the secretary in granting permit for said  
Gala be upheld

Greenock A.S.C. wrote asking permission to  
alter date of their Gala to 14<sup>th</sup> Oct. Permit  
was unanimously granted as desired

The Boys Brigade A.S.C. request for permit to  
hold a gala on 3<sup>rd</sup> November in Braeheadhill Baths  
was granted without dissent

Correspondence

Costa Glasgow Amateurs St. wrote intimating that it was proposed by said club to hold a confined Gala in Kinning Park Baths on 17<sup>th</sup> Oct & requesting permit to do so. Mr Brown seconded by Mr French moved that permit be granted as desired. The motion was agreed to without dissent.

Pollochshields Baths A.S.C. wrote asking for permit to hold a Gala on 25<sup>th</sup> November. The meeting unanimously agreed that permit be granted as desired.

Hamilton Crescent School Former Pupils A.S.C. were granted permit without objection to hold a Gala on 16<sup>th</sup> December.

A few letters was read in which Kinning Park A.S.C. asked permission to alter the date of said clubs Gala to 23<sup>rd</sup> December. The application was granted without dissent.

Mr Borland seconded the motion which  
was carried unanimously

The Congregational Churches Swimming Club  
Eastern section wrote applying for  
admission to the membership of the  
W.C.A.A. and enclosing required fee of £1.  
<sup>Subscription was also asked for a Gala on 8<sup>th</sup> November</sup>  
one guinea. Mr Kenzie seconded  
by Mr Brown moved that this Club  
be admitted & that the fee include  
next year's subscription as well as  
this year's. The motion was agreed to  
without objection.

St Andrews A.S.C. wrote asking for admission  
to the membership of the W.C. A.A. & asking  
permis to hold a gala on 8<sup>th</sup> November

It was pointed out that no rules nor  
affiliation fee had been sent. The matter  
was referred to President & Secretary to  
make arrangements on the motion of Mr  
Shedden seconded by Mr McLaughlin  
It was also agreed that in the event of  
this club being admitted the fee include  
next year's subscription

Treasurers Report The Treasurers Report was submitted, showing  
a credit balance of £ 14 16 9½ & intimating  
that several clubs fees were still unpaid  
These clubs were dealt with as follows:  
Motherwell Celtic, Cooperative, Thornlabank  
being defunct, were deleted from the roll of  
members.

Treasurer & Report Co-td. The Secretary was instructed to write to Rutherford Parish Church about their subscription & Glasgow Duckers who made application for an extension of time were granted this Mr Gentles seconded the adoption of the report which was agreed to.

Gates The Polo Report The Convener submitted his report & moved its adoption Mr Gentles seconded & the motion was agreed to now con.

Extension Mr Lawson reported that Bellahouston Committee Academicals intended to form a club & would affiliate next year.

Baths Mr Stewart asked if a Rod Room would be provided at Woodside Baths. Mr Fraser replied that nothing would be done this season but that the apparatus in question would be fixed up next year.

Times at Gala Committee Report (B.C.) This Committee's Report was read. The report recommended that G. Bernard be suspended for one month, C. Misbet (Carnegie) be suspended for one month and that R. Sharp (L.S.) be exonerated from blame & that the Wolfcot Club be exonerated from blame & that the 3<sup>rd</sup> prize in the 50yds race at L.S. Gala be handed to Mr Sharp.

This was agreed to, with the exception of the <sup>Misbet</sup> Bernard case, an amendment by Mr Walker that a recommendation be sent to F.C.A. Association that Bernard be suspended for one month being accepted by the meeting over.
