Review of 1987

Malta Trophy u/21 Four teams entered this year with Hamilton defeating Menzieshill in the final.

Willie Mellors u/17 Five teams entered this year with Hamilton defeating Dunfermline in the final.

Womens Championship It was disappointing that only two teams entered this year with Menzieshill being the winners.

Senior Inter District Only three districts participated with the East District retaining the trophy.

Junior Inter District This was played in the North District. The final was played between East and West with the East winning after two extra periods.

Scottish First Division Four teams accepted the invitiation to play in this competition. We had three teams finish on equal points and in the play-offs Dunfermline WP Club won the competition on goal difference (1 goal).
