1. Budget :-

It was noted that the estimate allowed for a Team of 22 (18 + 4) within a total of £3000. The Committee had been advised that the advantageous travel arrangements with accommodation would be marginally under £300 per head not including costs.

On the selection of two swimmers previously scheduled for Luxembourg who had withdrawn from that Meet and not replaced and the withdrawal of Angela from the Thames Valley Meet (for injury reasons), it was agreed that the savings would be put towards the cost of those additional swimmers for the Team to provide the necessary relay event personnel. It was also agreed that the outstanding balance be met from within the Swimming Committee budget for scheduled for July.
