### 1. Introduction

The Convener noted that the Meeting had been convened to up-date Members on some matters and to give provisional consideration to the business of the main meeting to be held following the last session of the 1990 National Short Course Championships.

# 2. Information Up-date

- a) Paisley '500' Trophy: the Convener noted that it was the responsibility of the Swimming Committee to nominate the award for the outstanding performance (male or female) of the Championships. With one session still to be swum, the probable nomination would be for Jean Hill for her Scottish Senior Record (100m Breaststroke) and for her overall performances. The Committee agreed to assemble by the announcer's table during the relays for the last session to confirm/amend that nomination.
- b) Senior Squad Competition: the Director of Swimming advised that there had been a problem of early December entry for the Leicester Meet which had negated the previous decision to invite those swimmers to 'nominate' the Meet of their choice. Under those circumstances the Committee agreed to offer (subject to satisfactory levels of performance) the Newcastle Meet to all Senior Squad Swimmers as a National Squad Selection.
- c) National Staff Selections: it was noted that there appeared to be a problem at the SASA Office as the confirmation of selection provided by the Convener had not been followed-through as required with the provision of notification to the selected staff/ Club/ employer. As this matter was now urgent, the Director of Swimming agreed to check progress at Stirling.

### 3. Viareggio

A provisional list of swimmers was considered and questions raised regarding the following:-

- i) Fiona Murray: state of health
- ii) Jennifer Lochray: competition fitness

These matters would be investigated prior to the later meeting.

#### Angela Pendrich

The Convener reported that he had discussed with Mrs. Pendrich several matters arising from previous correpsondence. Mr. Dashwood-Brady had been present during these discussions.

Broadly, Mrs. Pendrich was expressing disappointment that the SASA did not appear to be interested in Angela's performances, that Angela wanted to swim for Scotland and that the ASA had intimated their interest in Angela swimming for England. It was also suggested that the ASA had advised Mrs. Pendrich that the 'problems' of not competing on a Sunday would not occur with selection for England.

The Convener noted that he had not received any reply to his letters which recorded the considered views of the Swimming Committee and offered opportunity to discuss the matter further. Mrs. Pendrich stated that she had been advised by Mr. Garrie Roberts not to reply to SASA correspondence on this matter. In subsequent discussion with Mrs. Pendrich the Convener noted Angela's wish not to compete on Sundays and pointed out that under such circumstances her inclusion on merit to swim individual events could prejudice the Team if that extended to include team relay events on Sundays. Mrs. Pendrich agreed to give further consideration to this matter and to write to the Convener

### 4. (Continued)

The Swimming Committee noted that the Viareggio Meet would not be of an appropriate standard for Angela Pendrich and that the matter would be considered further on Sunday 23rd December. However, the view of the Committee was that Angela should be selected on merit for events and asked to give an undertaking that she would swim as selected for those events wherever they might fall within the competition days. Thereafter, it would be the responsibility of Angela (or her parents) to accept or reject that selection.

Dear Mr Brown

I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated the 8th inst with reference to SASA National Squad selection.

To say that I was disappointed is to put it mildly, I am utterly exasporated and devastated that you have simply sought to play with words rather that answer any of the questions or anomalies raised in my letter.

You state in your letter that I questioned the existence of a selection policy for the National squads, you then went on to state that there are consideration times that have to be made for selection, you also stated that Shelby Paul made two qualifying times and Rebecca Key only one.

I nor <u>ANY</u> coach that I have talked to are aware of <u>ANY</u> such qualifying times. These times which seem to have suddenly appeared are not in <u>ANY</u> selection policy that I have seen. I would like to again <u>REPEAT</u> my request that if there are such times that I may be sent a copy of these times and that they are made <u>public</u>.

I also request clarification that where does it state in the selection policy that  $\overline{\text{ANY}}$  event winner automatically gains selection to one of the squads according to age.

You' have stated that the consideration time for the 13 years 200m Butterfly was 2.40.00 secs, may I enquire from where did this time come from? It makes me wonder seeing that Rebecca Key was less than half a second outside of this so called consideration time and why was this consideration time never made public. I tried to point out in my letter that the only race that Shelby managed to beat Rebecca was one in which they were not competing against each other. I did not mention anything regarding this having disadvantaged Rebecca? Where did the word disadvantaged appear from?

When I queried with Mr K White as was suggested by Mr Black regarding the selection policies, he stated that it was his understanding that the

Age group Development squad would be for 12yrs old swimmers, he also agreed with myself regarding the lack of understanding regarding selection policies for various squads and that perhaps if there exists a table of consideration times then these are circulated, why is it that the people who paut all the graft into trying to produce these times are not aware of what these times are.

May I refer to a conversation I had with yourself Mr Brown regarding selection for representative meets, you stated that the Scottish council expected that each swimmer be able to represent across the board so to speak at all meets. I ask you simply this question which you, completely ignored in my previous letter "How can a swimmer who can beat another swimmer in FIVE I repeat five strokes can be deemed a less capable swimmer than the swimmer he/she can beat?

I represent a number of swimmers who are striving to gain selection from different National Squads therefore I do consider that as their representative and coach that I should be aware of all requirements including consideration times required.

My final point is simply that when a paper states 12yrs old as an obviously naive and innocent party I should have realised that it really meant 12yrs AND 13yr old. Forgive me for I have sinned.

I await your reply and a copy of the existing consideration times.
