SCOTTISH AMATEUR SWIMMING ASSOCIATION

REPORT on behalf of the SWIMMING COMMITTEE to the SASA COUNCIL MEETING of 14th OCTOBER 1990

1. Business from 19th August

Minutes and reports for the period 19th August to date are attached for the reference of Council :-

- Swimming Committee : Minute of Meeting of 31st August (Approved without any amendment).
- Swimming Committee : Minute of Meeting of 30th September (Draft- subject to approval).

2. Items for the attention of Council

(a) Minute of 31st August 1990

Page 3 : Item 3 a : Internal Commonwealth Games Report

The Swimming Committee recommends the approval of the Internal Report produced by the Director of Swimming and seeks the support of Council for the recommendations contained within that Report.

The Swimming Committee is particularly concerned to be able to support the preparation and participation of swimmers, divers and synchronised swimmers in an appropriate programme during the lead-in to the 1994 Commonwealth Games. To that end it is considered important that an early start is made to the establishment of a separately contracted fund raising scheme.

The Swimming Committee is also concerned to ensure that there be established an effective, co-ordinated and agreed procedure to deal with planning and actions leading towards those Games.

(b) Minute of 30th September 1990

Pages 2 and 3 : Item 3 (90.330) : Inter-District Contest

Following extensive discussion, the Swimming Committee has provided a broad remit to the Convener for the drafting of Changes to Rules : these drafts are to be considered by the next meeting of the Swimming Committee.

(c) Minute of Joint Meeting (Diving and Synchro) of 30th September

The draft Minute hopefully reflects the broad pattern of agreement on the response to the discussion document prepared by the Chairman of the Commonwealth Games Council.

(d) Report from Convener : Commonwealth Games Council Meeting

Despite the combined efforts of all our SASA representatives, we were unable to achieve separate recognition for swimming, diving and synchronised swimming with allocated numbers for 1994.

However, it is hoped that we can still achieve an increase in the overall allocation from 16 to 18 competitors.

(e) Report from Convener : Scottish Sports Association
